LOCAL CHAMPIONSHIP RACE

June 12 & 13, 2010 Tuolumne City, CA

NEW LOCATION: The 2010 Championship Race will be held at a new location, Tuolumne City, CA, in conjunction with the 61st Tuolumne Lumber Jubilee.

WHEN/WHERE: **Saturday, June 12, 2010 Mandatory Car Inspection / Weigh-in:** 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM .
Location: Inspection will be held in the parking area of the Mother Lode Christian School at the top of Pine St. in Tuolumne City. See the attached map with address and directions. All cars must complete inspection on Saturday to race on Sunday. First time drivers will receive one practice run in the afternoon. After inspection on Saturday, all cars will be impounded and stored overnight for the race on Sunday.

Sunday, June 13, 2010 Race Day

Check-in/Weigh-in: 7:30 AM, at the Mother Lode Christian School,
Driver's Meeting: 9:00 AM, Racing Starts: 9:30 AM, Awards: 4:00 PM
Race course: Newly paved Pine St. in Tuolumne City, CA. See the attached map for directions.

DIVISIONS:

Stock:	Ages 8 to 13,	200 lb maximum weight,	107.5 lb maximum tail weight
Super Stock:	Ages 10 to 17,	230 lb maximum weight,	122.5 lb maximum tail weight
Masters:	Ages 10 to 17,	255 lb maximum weight,	135.0 lb maximum tail weight

RULES: The 2010 All-American Soap Box Derby rules apply. All drivers must wear adequate foot protection with a sole while racing. For more information on rules, go to www.aasbd.org .

Age: Please bring a copy of the racer's **BIRTH CERTIFICATE** with you to the check-in table. This is required for all event participants. Racers must be of age by the date of the local race and must not turn 18 before August 1, 2010.

Race Format: Double Elimination, Lane Swap, Wheel Swap, Timer Differential. Heat winners may be subject to re-weighing after each heat. One practice run is available for first time racers.

Inspection: Each car will be inspected thoroughly prior to the race. Please arrive "inspection-ready". You must provide your own weights. All cars may have shells removed from the floorboard on Saturday. The contestants may be required to put their car shell back onto their floorboard during the inspection (be sure to bring any tools you need to do this). Any protest concerning car construction must be lodged before the first heat. No protests will be accepted after racing has begun (exception: if someone alters their car after racing starts).

Wheels: Z-Glas. Please bring your own wheels and label them with your name. Each racer is responsible for retrieving their wheels at the end of the day. You will start the race on your wheels, but you will not keep your wheels after the first phase. Wheels will rotate from car to car throughout the day, and you will get your wheels back at the end of the race. If you need to leave early, and your wheels are still in use, please let the Race Director know and arrangements will be made to retrieve your wheels for you. No lubrication may be added after the race starts.

AWARDS: Trophies: 1st – 6th places in Stock and Super Stock. 1st- 3rd places in Masters. Winners of each division will be eligible to represent NCSBD in Akron, Ohio on July 24, 2010.

ENTRY FEE: \$35 per racer prior to May 29, 2009. T-shirt included.
\$45 per racer after May 29, 2009. Please make check payable to NCSBD.

FOOD: Food booths will available to serve hot food, chips, soft drinks and bottled water.

LOCAL MOTELS: See list below. The Aladdin, Gunn House, and Inns of California allow one night stays in June. The Best Western requires two nights minimum. The Gunn House and Inns of CA have less parking available for a trailer since they are closer to downtown. The Aladdin has a AAA rate for two Queens of \$80.10 + tax, non-AAA rate is \$86. We tried to get a group rate there, but a large wedding party has booked much of the hotel, and the Aladdin will not be able to allocate a block of rooms until May 12 when some rooms may be released from the wedding block. There may be a small number of rooms available at the Aladdin. Rooms fill early due to the summer season so make your reservations ASAP.

Check-in / Race Address: 18393 Gardner Avenue, Tuolumne City, CA 95379

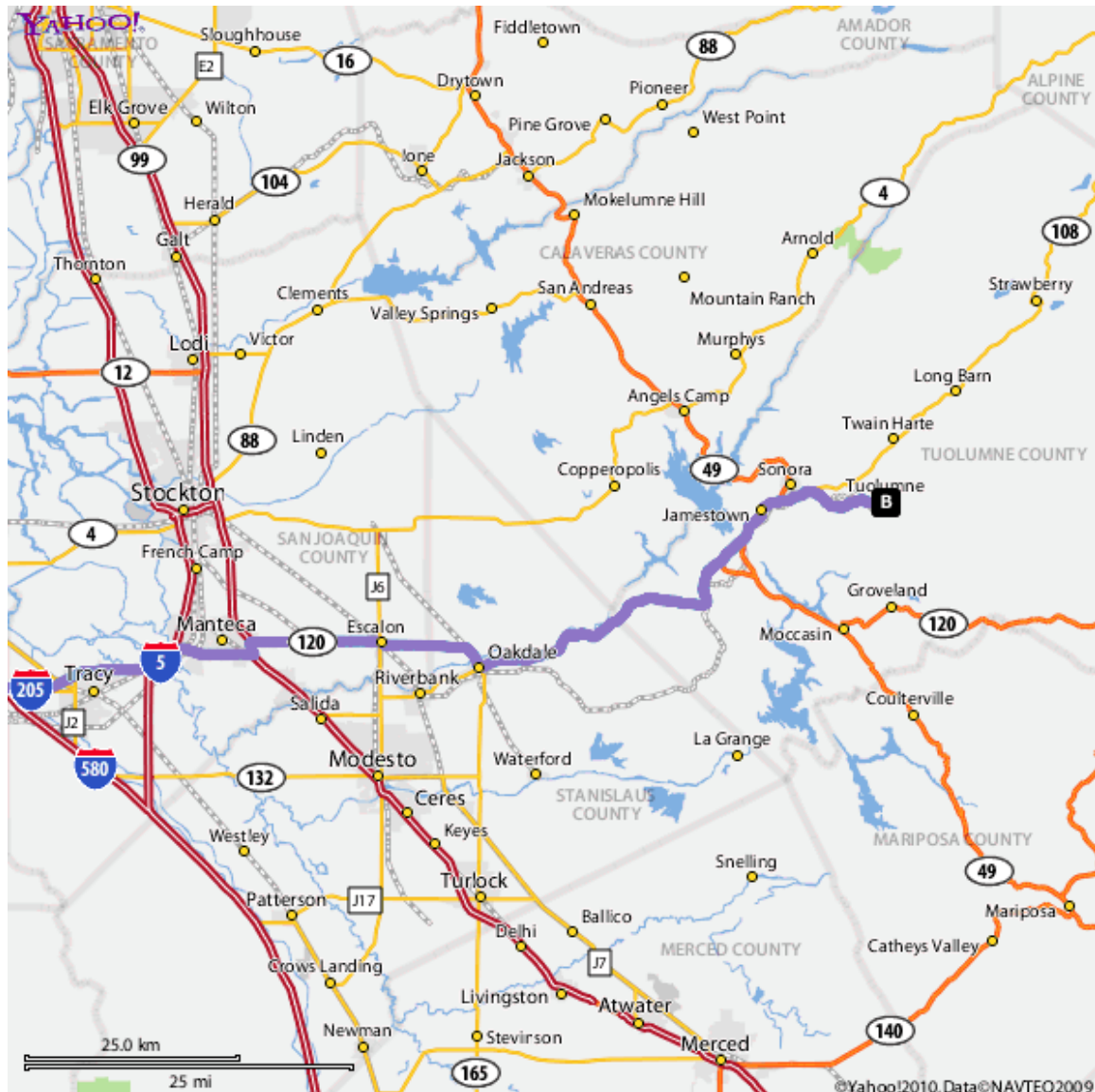
From North: US 99 South; CA 4 (Farmington Rd) East for 35 mi.; CR-E15 (O'Byrnes Ferry Road) East for 13 mi.; CA 108 East (left) for 10 mi., then follow directions "From Sonora" below.

From Bay Area: I-580 East; I-205 East 13 mi.; I-5 North, 1 mi.; CA 120 East, 6 mi.; CA 120/99 North 0.5 mi.; CA 120 East, 20 mi.; CA 108 East (left) for 35 mi., then follow directions "From Sonora" below.

From South: US 99 North to Turlock; J14 North for 19 mi.; CA 108 East (left) for 35 mi., then follow directions "From Sonora" below.

From Sonora: From CA-108, Take Mono Way, right 5 mi; Tuolumne Rd. right 6.8 mi.; Pine St. right for one block; Check-in (Mother Lode Christian School) is on the right at Pine and Gardner Streets.
